A fine Regency period mahogany bracket clock by Cade and Robinson of London. The three pad, arched-top case, veneered with finely figured mahogany of good color and patination, has a brass carrying handle and a full opening front door with a cast brass bezel and convex glass.

The white convex enamel dial, 7 inches in diameter, has Roman hour numerals and minute divisions. The blued steel hands are of the delicate interlacing scroll pattern. The movement runs for eight days and strikes the hours on a bell. There is a repeat cord for repeating the previous hour, and the backplate is beautifully engraved with scrolls and flowers.
